Introduction To Medicine Of Older Adults For Healthcare Professionals

Geriatric Training For Non-Geriatrician

Introduction:

The number of Older Adults is increasing worldwide. According to the WHO, between the years 2015 and 2050, the proportion of the world's population over 60 years will nearly double from 12% to 22%.

In Kuwait, the total number of Older Adults in 2021 was 122,004 which constitutes 2.6% of the general population. In 1972, the percentage of Older Adults in Kuwait was 1.8%. This indicates that within the past 50 years the percentage of Older people had almost doubled.

The increasing number of Older Adults mandates skill training, education of healthcare professionals, and the development of a clear plan to close the gap between the latest guidelines and current practice.

Key message:

The importance of continuous medical education in updating the evidence-based knowledge of healthcare professionals and building the skills needed in their practice. The diversity of the training and information delivery modes involved in the workshop ensures that information is circulated and shared between participants in a mutual learning process that involves feedback, interaction and pooling of knowledge.

Objectives:

The aim of this workshop is to:

- ▶ Provide the latest evidence-based medical updates regarding common geriatric healthcare problems using a holistic method of care.
- ▶ Train healthcare workers on performing the clinical skills and different assessment tools necessary for the evaluation and management of Older Adults in an efficient timely manner.
- Develop and improve effective communication skills with the older adult and his caregivers across different socioeconomic and cultural backgrounds.
- ▶ Train health care workers on how to Educate and support older adult patients and their caregivers to enable a shared management plan through a patient (and family) centered approach to care.
- ▶ Train health care practitioners in how to educate and counsel older adults and their caregivers on disease prevention and health promotion.
- ▶ Train participants on how to formulate a personalized care plan in coordination with other members of the interdisciplinary team involved in the care of older adults.
- ▶ Initiate channels of continuous collaboration with GCC countries to exchange relevant cross-cultural experiences and best practices.

Expected Outcomes:

By the end of the workshop, the participants will be able to

- ▶ Understand the person-centered model of care in clinical decision making.
- ▶ Utilize latest evidence-based tools and models when managing geriatric health care problems.
- Implement a personalized care plan in coordination with other health care providers within the interdisciplinary team involved in the care of older adults.
- ▶ Implement healthcare plans targeted towards preventing health problems or maintaining health.
- Apply the acquired skills and tools needed for functional assessment, management treatment and counseling of various health conditions related to older adults.
- Acquire strategies for effective communication, education and support of the older adult and his caregivers.
- ▶ Identify channels of continuous collaboration with GCC countries to exchange relevant expertise.



The Target Audience

Methodology:

- The program is based on a blended and problem-based Adult educational format consisting of in-class training, technical presentations, simulated cases and interactive individual and group discussions, calling upon participants' own expertise and cross-cultural experiences. By the end of the workshop, each group will be given an assignment to be performed in accordance with a plan of action developed. Each participant will then be requested to report on the lessons learned.
- ➤ The program will be jointly designed and delivered by the ministry of health, GCC members and WHO regional representatives under the guidance of MOH Kuwait, delivered by the Directorate of Health Services for Older Adults.
